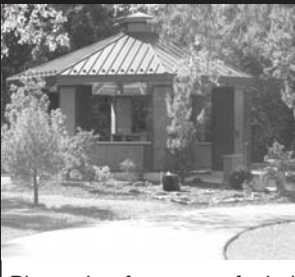
The Priests' Pension Collection envelope allows each of us to show our gratitude and support for priests who have faithfully served our parishes and cared for us and our spiritual needs.
