Easter Flower Decorations

The Easter *Triduum* begins with the Vigil of Holy Thursday, March 24th. It marks the end of the forty days of Lent and the beginning of the three-day celebration of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ - Holy Thursday (Mass begins at 7:00 p.m.), Good Friday (11:00 a.m. Children's Liturgy and 3:00 p.m. Solemn Celebration) and Easter Vigil (Mass at 7:00 p.m.) and Easter Sunday (Mass at 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.) The Fathers of the Second Vatican Council reminded us of the extraordinary significance of the *Triduum*: "Christ redeemed us all and gave perfect glory to God principally through his paschal mystery: dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life. Therefore the Easter Triduum of the passion and resurrection of Christ is the culmination of the entire liturgical year." (General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, # 18)

Remember, 3 days, 1 Solemn Celebration.
