ASH WEDNESDAY



Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

Our foreheads our marked with ashes to humble our hearts and reminds us that life passes away on Earth. We remember this when we hear the words "Repent and believe in the Gospel," or Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return." Ashes are a symbol of penance made sacramental by the blessing of the Church and they help us to develop a spirit of humility and charity.

Ashes are made from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year. They are a reminder that God is gracious and merciful to those who call on Him with repentant hearts. Divine mercy is of utmost importance during this holy season of Lent. May this be a grace filled season and one of ongoing conversion as we come closer to the heart and mind of Jesus.


