# What God Does Reveals Who God Is

Much of our western world is defined according to productivity. Value is placed on what we are able to produce, so much so that to be non-productive in the modern sense can mean laziness. However, this is not Christian thought. What we do should flow from who we are, not the other way around. For example, growing up my parents provided the necessities of life for me, namely protection, food, shelter and most of all love. This action on their part could not possibly be reduced to an act of productivity. Rather, this act of parenting flows from who they are. So much so to refer to my mother as the cook would seem outrageous.

Today's feast reminds us exactly of this reality. Whereas all other feast days in the Church's calendar focus on what God does for us today's feast focuses on who God is. What do God's actions reveal about God's nature? Simply put, as scripture reveals, God is Love. Everything we celebrate flows from the simple act of God's unconditional love for his people.

This is the core of the Trinitarian mystery. The Father is deeply in love with the Son and the Son is deeply in love with the Father and the bond of their love is the Holy Spirit. It is according to this union that we can say that God is three persons and one God. From this union of love between Father Son and Holy Spirit life is given. When we realize that the source of our being is love, then and only then do we discover the value of what we do.
