6th Sunday of Easter

While we are currently celebrating the resurrection of Jesus during this six week span of Easter, the Gospel of today looks back in liturgical time. We have the Spirit of Jesus to guide us and support us along the journey of ups and downs. Do I trust in God's assurance for me?

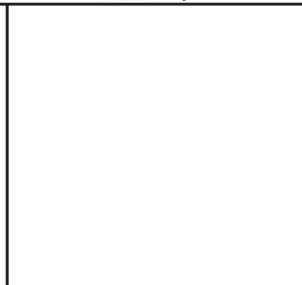
