### A Note from Jaclyn Bergeron from NET Canada!

Training has been a roller coaster of emotions so far! The first couple days I just really wanted to go home but I knew that I couldn't. I had Thursday to basically just settle in and relax and I cried all afternoon and night and much of Friday as well. The first opportunity I got to call home I took it! We have had many sessions already, some of them about Mary as our mother, a deeper intro to NET and the teams for the year, the heart of worship and the ultimate relationship as well as the PAC code as a NET missionary. We had laundry night, Monday the 29<sup>th</sup> it was very fun but also hectic...so I was dumb and put my clothes in the washing machines twice on accident and my clothes got full of Kleenex the first time since I forgot to take it out of my pocket! We were not late back to camp and we had a great time jamming out to music in the car! So far it was the first night I felt no homesickness. We have had mass everyday and personal prayer.

On the weekends the NET staff leaves so the "Netters" get a pretty chill weekend! On Sunday we had hermit day! So from the time we wake up till 5:30 dinner time we have to stay in complete silence... So it was interesting!

On August 30<sup>th</sup> we had God the father night and it was such a touching prayer experience and made me really reflect on my relationship with my Heavenly Father but also my earthy fathers. It was a very emotional night. The 31<sup>st</sup> and the first of September was women's retreat! Those were some super packed days but lots of fun. We did a giant slip and slide (a lot of us including me slide right into the mud and had some pain☺). We talked about our 6 truths as women, how to relate to girls better and also relating to guys better! We also learned the true meaning of love and it is sacrificial love. We played lots of games, had a picnic at the beach, watched Cinderella and had a slumber party and sleep over night with ice cream and popcorn and lots more. The next night we heard some personal testimonies about struggles for women and they were so touching. The last thing we did at women's retreat was a campfire and s'mores!


Today Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup> the boys and girls are back together and we are learning about temperaments and which one or two reflect us and how we can use them to become closer to that goal of perfection to one day be in heaven.
