#### **Parish Pastoral Council**

The role of Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) as a leadership body which works to discern the mission of the parish & to envision the ways in which that mission is lived out in the parish. As we seek to discern member of Most Precious Blood Parish to serve on the PPC we need to examine the qualities that we are looking for in council members. Specifically, we are looking for leaders who embody the following qualities:

- Desire for spiritual growth in oneself & the parish
- Enthusiasm about eh future of our Parish/ Parish of Families
- Ability to study issues, reflect on them and draw sound conclusions
- Eagerness to facilitate parish decisions about its direction
- Courage to work toward consensus
- Capacity to listen outweighing the need to speak
- Integrity in articulating what one has heard and what one believes
- Ability to inspire and empower
- Willingness to delegate
- Flexibility and openness with people and ideas

In addition, Council members would have to have the time to commit to attending the monthly meeting of Council, and other committee meetings as deemed necessary by Council. If you feel that these qualities describe you and you would like to take an active role in helping to set the direction for the parish, the Pastoral Team invites you to prayerfully consider if God is calling you to ministry on PPC.

Similarly, if you know another member of the parish who has these qualifications, pray about suggesting their name.
