### 40 DAYS FOR LIFE

The 40 Days for Life movement is an ecumenical pro-life campaign to bring an end to abortion. Since it started in 2004, Catholics and people of other faith traditions have participated in the campaign. The campaign is built on prayer and fasting, and a peaceful 40-day prayer vigil outside an abortion facility. During the 40-day vigil, parishes will be asked to join together in prayer for repentance, healing, and an end to abortion in our country.

The fall campaign for the Windsor 40 Days for Life will begin on September 26<sup>th</sup> and run until November 2<sup>nd</sup>, outside Met Hospital at Tecumseh Road.

The 40 Days for Life has proven to be an effective means of helping to build a culture of life and to bring people's consciousness an evil which is often hidden in our society.
