CALL FOR CONSCIENCE CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Close to 30,000 letters were sent directly to our elected officials and many communities personally met with their local MPP advocating for conscience protection in Bill 84, legislation relating to assisted suicide.

On April 11, the Ontario Liberal majority on the Bill 84 committee voted to defeat Conservative Party amendments to protect the conscience rights of doctors/nurses. Therefore, no such protection will be in the legislation.

The Call for Conscience campaign also asked the government to establish a client care coordinator system allowing patients to directly access a "telehealth" line where they can be directed to information regarding end of life services including palliative care, pain management, home care and, if they so choose, assisted death. This will be taking place. While we pray that patients will not pursue assisted suicide, the model will eliminate the need for physician referral in most cases. The campaign asked for an approach consistent with what has been set up in Alberta (where conscientious objectors are not involved in any way). It appears the Ontario model will be modified and may still require a physician referral if requested, which remains problematic.

The Conservative Party has stated that they plan to introduce a private members' bill on conscience rights. However, as the Liberals have a majority government, it is unlikely that the private members' bill will pass. At present, there is a court case against the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) by four doctors who are challenging their effective referral policy. If they win the case, it could force CPSO to change their policy. Regardless of outcome, there may be numerous appeals and we anticipate a lengthy road ahead.

We will continue to advocate for conscience protection and encourage you to share your concerns with your own MPP. Please continue to pray for all those impacted by issues of conscience and for all those who are sick and suffering among us.
