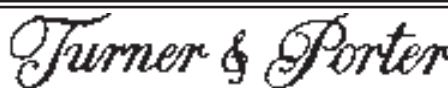
PARISH PICNIC

ANTI-BULLYING LEGISLATION AND BILL 13

There has been significant public dialogue regarding anti-bullying legislation currently being considered by our Members of Provincial Parliament. A number of partners from our faith community have been actively engaged in this process for many months. In January 2012, the Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association (OCSTA), in collaboration with the Assembly of Catholic Bishops of Ontario (ACBO) released, "*Respecting Difference*", a guideline for dealing with issues of Equity, Inclusivity & Bullying in our Catholic schools. This template has been provided to Catholic School Boards and is in use throughout the province. You can access the document through the Archdiocese of Toronto website: www.archtoronto.org

There are currently two bills before the Legislature on the issue of bullying: Bill 13, introduced by the current Government and Bill 14, a Private Members Bill introduced by a member of the Official Opposition. While the ACBO and OCSTA agree with the objective of eradicating bullying in any form, they are currently discussing possible amendments that they feel will help clarify and strengthen the implementation of the legislation. Our approach to dealing with the difficult issue of bullying in our Catholic Schools will be centred on our faith, treating each person as a child of God, accepted with compassion, love and respect.
