### STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

Mansu Han of Han Stained Glass will begin work on all the stained glass windows that remain to be done: the 8 large windows in the nave (the narrow ones with openers have already been done) and the 4 windows in the choir loft. We decided to get the work done now because he has offered us a 20% discount. The total cost will be \$41,000 plus HST. Please keep that in mind in the next Maintenance and Debt Collection.

### CATHOLIC SCHOOL EQUITY AND INCLUSIVITY POLICY

Archbishop Collins is encouraging us to get involved in the consultation process that will result in the school board's equity and inclusivity policy.

Concerned parishioners have already approached us to state their hope that many people will indeed express their views on this topic, because there is a well-founded fear that such a policy could undermine the Catholic School Board's ability to teach the truth about human sexuality and provide an environment to reinforce

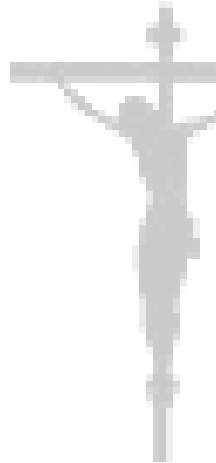


#### PILGRIMAGE TO THE DIVINE MERCY SHRINE
