Father Daniel is the second of our Oratorian Fathers to celebrate his silver jubilee during this year of the priest. Father Juvenal Merriell's twenty-fifth anniversary was on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, last December 8th.

The festivities for Father Daniel's anniversary will be on Sunday, April 18. He will celebrate the 11 a.m. Latin Mass at Holy Family, followed by a public reception in the parish hall. The reception will continue long enough for parishioners of St Vincent's to get there after the 11:30 a.m. Mass here.

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

The finance committee has approved more stained glass restoration. All the windows in the sanctuary will be restored as well as all the windows on the north side of the nave that can be opened and closed. The windows will be taken out, cleaned, and repaired. They will be reinstalled

with an outside pane of tempered glass as protection against vandalism and the elements.

We have engaged the same company that did the windows on the south side of the nave in 2008 -- Han Stained Glass. Work will begin on the Monday of Easter Week. The total cost of the project will be 52,560 + GST. Mansu Han and his company have promised to donate back to the parish the cost of repairing the steel vents on the seven nave windows (\$750 per window / \$5,250 total).

We do not have quite enough money in the bank to do the project, but the finance committee has decided to ask for a loan from the Archdiocese so that we can begin the project now for two main reasons. (1) The windows are getting progressively worse and the longer that we put off fixing them, the more expensive it will be to repair them. And some, such as the ones in the sanctuary, are causing water damage to the inside of the building. (2) Getting it done now will save the increased cost of the HST, which takes effect on July 1. The 8% increase in taxes is an increase of over \$4,000 for the project. We hope that you will agree that this is prudent decision and keep the project in mind, especially at the time of the next Maintenance and Debt Collection on May 2.
