Working wonders for people who are homeless...

While at Matt Talbot we helped Richard reunite with his brother, who was lost to him through separate adoptions. He was also able to deal with his mother's death, a woman he had mixed feelings about, because she was the person who originally committed him to the system as a young child. Today Richard is working odd jobs; he drinks rarely and still has his apartment. He still overflows with teenage-boy energy, although he is approaching 60 and stands 6'5". There is a calm to Richard that's new. Some of that calm comes from his maturing while in the Matt Talbot Program. Some of it comes from us learning when to let go and to move people along to their next phase of growth.

In Toronto alone there are at least 1,500 homeless people on any given night. On an annual basis ShareLife agencies provide food, shelter, guidance, care and counselling to more than 10,000 people in the Greater Toronto Area.

The goal of our parish this year is to raise \$14,000. To date we have raised \$5600.
