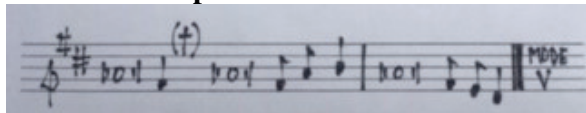

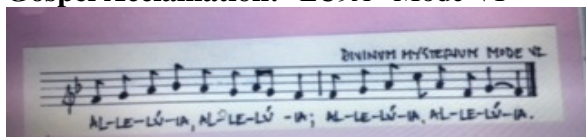

### AD ORIENTEM

Beginning on the evening of Saturday, April 21, all the Masses at Holy Family and St Vincent de Paul Church will be said *ad orientem*. This means that for the liturgy of the Eucharist, the priest will face the Tabernacle (the liturgical "orient" or east). We are inspired to make this return to the tradition by the recent visit of Cardinal Robert Sarah to Toronto, during which he urged priests to be "prudentially audacious" in saying Masses *ad orientem*. Cardinal Sarah is the prefect of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. He has urged this in other contexts as well, arguing that this is the traditional liturgical posture. It involves the priest and the congregation both turning towards God to offer a pure sacrifice to Him. This orientation highlights the fact that the Mass is a sacrifice and it has always been permitted by the post-Vatican II liturgical documents.
