HABEMUS SANCTOS!

On Sunday, April 27, two popes, John XXIII and John Paul II, will be canonized by Pope Francis. Affectionately known as "The Good Pope", John XXIII called the historic Second Vatican Council (1962–65). However, he did not live to see it to completion, dying on 3 June 1963 of stomach cancer, four-and-a-half years after his election. A nun with a terminal stomach condition obtained a complete cure after placing herself under his protection. His cause for canonization was opened on 18 November 1965 by his successor, Pope Paul VI, and he was beatified on 3 September 2000 by Pope John Paul II. His feast day is not celebrated on the date of his death as is usual, but it is on 11 October, the day of the first session of the Second Vatican Council.

John Paul II's cause for canonisation commenced in 2005 shortly after his death with the traditional five year waiting period waived. On 19 December 2009, John Paul II was proclaimed Venerable by his successor Pope Benedict XVI and was beatified on 1 May 2011 after the Congregation for the Causes of Saints attributed a miracle to him, the healing of a French nun from Parkinson's disease. Like Pope John XXIII, his feast day is not celebrated on the date of his death, but on 22 October, the anniversary of his papal inauguration in 1978.
