NOVENA PRAYER TO ST. MONICA



St. Monica, the mother of St. Augustine, Bishop of Hippo, is well known for her tireless prayers which eventually won the conversions of her illtempered, pagan husband, and her brilliant but loose-living son. She is an inspiration for all who suffer the loss of faith

of a loved one and who wish to labour in prayer for their return or conversion to a Christian life. If we follow her prayerful example, we may draw encourgement from the words of St. Ambrose, on hearing of her long and lonely crusade for her wayward son: "It is not possible for the child of so many tears to perish." Here is a popular novena to St. Monica for the conversion of loved ones:

Dear St Monica, troubled wife and mother, Many sorrows pierced your heart During your lifetime. Yet you never despaired or lost faith. With confidence, persistence and profound faith, You prayed daily for the conversion Of your beloved husband, Patricius And your beloved son, Augustine.

> Grant me that same fortitude, Patience and trust in the Lord. Intercede for me, dear St. Monica, That God may favorably hear my plea For (mention your petition here).

And grant me the grace To accept his will in all things, Through Jesus Christ, our Lord, In the unity of the Holy Spirit, One God forever and ever. Amen.
