#### **BL. JUVENAL ANCINA**



Blessed Juvenal is the only one of our Oratorian Blesseds to have known St Philip personally. A physician, he was moved to a deeper practice of his Faith one day when hearing the *Dies Irae* at a funeral. He and his brother Giovanni Matteo went to Rome seeking a vocation and thought of

joining the Carthusians. On a second trip to Rome Juvenal discovered the Oratory, and St Philip persuaded him to join, where he became one of the most popular preachers, and also composed music which was used at the Oratory exercises. In 1586 he was sent to the new Oratory at Naples, where his fame as a good preacher and holy priest continued to grow. When there was talk that he would be made a bishop he went into hiding for several months, but after St Philip's death he was unable to avoid the desires of the Holy Father and in 1602 was made Bishop of Saluzzo in Piedmont. St Francis de Sales was a close friend and gave testimony at the Process for Juvenal's beatification.

In 1604 Juvenal was poisoned by a friar whom he had rebuked for scandalous living, but refused to testify against him.

Juvenal's body rests in Saluzzo Cathedral, under an altar dedicated to him. He was beatified by Pope Leo XIII on 9th February, 1890, and his feast is kept each year on 30th August.

#### PASSION OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST

On June 24 the Church celebrated the happy event of St. John the Baptist's appearance in this world; today she honours his entry into heaven. Apart from our Divine Lord and our Lady, he is the only saint whose birth and death are both celebrated in this way. After his forty years in the desert, where he had flourished like the palm tree and grown great as a cedar of Lebanon (John the Forerunner had the courage to reproach Herod to his face for his unlawful and scandalous union with his sister-in-law, Herodias, whose husband, Philip, was still living. Herodias prevailed on Herod to imprison him; then through her daughter Salome she was given an unexpected opportunity to obtain the beheading of the saint who opposed her criminal passion. St. John had witnessed to Christ by his birth, his preaching and his baptism; today he completes his testimony by his martyrdom. He was put to death at about the time of the Pasch, a year before Christ's Passion, but the feast of his death is kept on August 29, the anniversary of the finding of his head at Emesa in Syria in 452.
