ALBERTA – FLOOD RELIEF

Floods in Calgary and the surrounding area have resulted in tragic deaths and the displacement of more than 100,000 people, who had to evacuate their homes and businesses. Thousands remain in shelters, while others have just started returning to assess the damages. The archdiocese has been in touch with the chancery staff of the Catholic Diocese of Calgary – the Calgary chancery remains closed as a result of the flooding, however, they are now able to accept contributions to the diocesan relief efforts in Alberta. Calgary Bishop Frederick Henry has indicated his intent to use any charitable contributions to support victims in the areas who need it most. Bishop Henry will convene a committee to assess the needs of the greater community and establish further priorities.

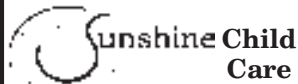
