FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. PHILIP NERI

In celebration of the 500th anniversary of the birth of St Philip Neri (21st July 1515), Pope Francis has granted a Jubilee Year with an attached Plenary Indulgence, subject to the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff). During the Jubilee Year, which runs from 25th May 2015 to 26th May 2016, the indulgence can be gained every day in our church (and in any other church of a canonically established Congregation of the Oratory). To gain the indulgence, a pilgrimage must be made, or one should take part in a service or devotion in honour of St Philip, concluding by saying the Our Father and Creed and prayers to the Blessed Virgin Mary and St Philip. The indulgence may be applied to the faithful departed.

WALKING PILGRIMAGE TO MARTYRS' SHRINE, MIDLAND

The date for the pilgrimage is **August 24-29**. This is open to boys and girls between grade 7 (September) and first year university. After 7:45 a.m. Mass followed by breakfast at Holy Family on August 24th, pilgrims will be driven to Colgan, Ontario to begin to walk. The plan is to arrive at Midland on August 28th in the afternoon, stay overnight at Martyrs' Shrine, and return to Toronto Saturday afternoon. Total walking distance is 120 km, mainly along bicycle and snowmobile trails and along roads with sparse traffic. Cost is \$70. Benefits priceless. Permission form must be filled out. These are at the back of the church.

WORLD YOUTH DAY 2016 - KRAKOW, POLAND

The official dates for WYD next year are July 26 - 31. We are tentatively planning to leave Toronto on July 17 / 18 / 19 and return on August 4 / 5. The plan is to fly to Prague and spend a few days there and then transfer by bus to Slovakia for some hiking in the Tatra Mountains before arriving in Krakow on July 25. After WYD, we plan to spend some time visiting Our Lady of Czestochowa, Auschwitz, and Wadowice
