**DOCTORS NEED YOUR HELP!**

Doctors in Ontario currently have the right to decline to provide non-emergency care that does not conform to their own moral and/or religious beliefs. This allows them to opt out of non-emergency case referrals, such as abortions, emergency contraception and other medical care that violates their own conscience.

The new policy will provide guidelines for physicians practicing medicine in Ontario. There is pressure on the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario to include language in their policy that would require doctors to offer or refer patients for such non-emergency care, forcing them to go against their own personal beliefs.

CPSO is accepting feedback on their website until August 5, 2014 (google "cpso have your say"). **Please take some time (about 15 minutes) to fill in the anonymous survey to make sure that conscientious doctors can continue to practice in Ontario.**


