Maintenance and Debt Collection, TODAY!

The fourth and final Maintenance and Debt Collection for 2010 will be taken up next week. There is a special need for your generosity because this year we have not been doing well with this collection. The first three such collections have produced about 20,000 whereas last year at this time, we were at 26,000 and, in 2007, the year we started these collections, we were at 29,000. The parish at this point is running very close to the line. In order to do the much needed repair work on the stained glass windows -- total cost \$52,000 -- we had to take out a loan of \$20,000. This brought our total loan to \$34,000. We have not paid anything off the principal this year. Presently, we are having to hold cheques back until the Sunday collection gives us enough breathing room to pay

them off. Of course, in the meantime, other bills arrive. I do not need to describe this situation in more detail because it is a common experience for many people. There is much life and generosity in the parish that the precarious finances are not a cause for panic and despair. But they are a cause for concern and I thought it only fair to let you know of our state of finances as we prepare for the next Maintenance and Debt Collection. **Please make use of the envelopes at the back of the church, and please be generous!**

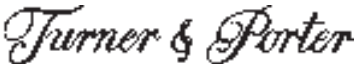
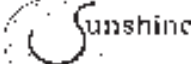
