CAMPAIGN UPDATE

The Family of Faith Campaign is doing great in St Vincent de Paul Parish! With adjustment of some pledge amounts,

our total as of Thursday morning stood at \$222,560 from 33 donors. This puts us over our parish goal of \$215,000.

Today is Commitment Sunday, the official ending date of our campaign drive. In case anyone was overlooked during the campaign (for which we apologize), we will be asking each family to fill out a card in the pew, even if you have already made your pledge.

As the pledges are redeemed, St Vincent's will keep more than \$50,000 of the donations toward our goal (25% of the first \$215,000, minus a charge for fundraising costs), and 75% of all funds collected above the goal.

PRESENTATION OF THE LORD



On February 2 the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, which occurs 40 days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas, since the blessing and procession of candles is included in the day's liturgy.

There will be a Sung English Mass at Holy Family Church at 5:30 p.m.

ST. BLAISE



There are few facts known about this saint of the fourth century. According to legends, he was of noble birth and was raised a Christian. He became a priest and then Bishop of Sebastea in Armenia. In the time of persecution he

fled to the mountains, living in a cave where he tended to the sick and wounded animals. He saved a young boy who was choking to death with a fishbone in his throat. When he was captured and imprisoned the boy's mother gave him food and candles. Thus the practice of blessing throats with candles on St. Blaise's feast day, as we will do after the 8 a.m. Mass on February 3. As legend goes, St. Blaise's flesh was torn with wool combs before he was beheaded. He is the patron of throat illness, attacks of wild animals and veterinarians.
