

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

In 1917, Our Lady appeared at Fatima in Portugal. She encouraged the Church to take up the rosary. When our parishioners were raising money to build our church a few years later, they built a beautiful altar with a remarkable statue of Mary. Our Lady is depicted as she is on the miraculous medal. She has her hands out to spread many graces to her children.

In this centenary year of our parish, she seems to be offering St Vincent's special spiritual favours. In response we want to begin again to answer Our Lady's call for the daily rosary. For many years the rosary has been crucial to the life of our parish and its faithful parishioners. Last week we looked at what Pope Benedict XVI once said about the rosary. Today let's ponder the words of one of the Fatima visionaries, Sr Lucia!

"After the sacred Eucharistic liturgy, the Rosary is the prayer that brings us closest to the mysteries of faith, hope, and love. It is spiritual bread for souls. He who does not say it withers and dies.

In saying it, we find God, in finding God, we are given faith, hope, and love without which we cannot be saved.

The Rosary is a prayer for the rich and for the poor, for the learned and the not-so-learned. To deprive souls of this devotion is to deprive them of their spiritual nourishment.

This prayer keeps alive the spark of faith that is not yet fully extinguished in many consciences. Even those who say it without meditating on the mysteries are reminded of God and of the supernatural by the fact of simply taking hold of the beads. Simply to call to mind the mysteries for the length of one decade is to catch hold of a ray of light that sustains the still smoldering wick of many souls."
