

CAMPAIGN UPDATE

We are over the top! As of Wednesday, January 21, we had received pledges totaling \$221,050 from

just twenty-six donors. This puts us over our parish goal of \$215,000. As the pledges are redeemed, St Vincent's will keep more than \$50,000 of the donations toward our goal (25% of the first \$215,000, minus a charge for fundraising costs), and 75% of all funds collected above the goal.

Those who are considering a pledge can drop off your completed pledge form at the parish office or put it in the collection in an envelope marked "Family of Faith". One-time donations are accepted, but we ask you to consider a pledge to this important cause. Our official parish campaign ends the weekend of January 31 -February 1 with Commitment Sunday. Anyone who has not had the opportunity to give a pledge will be given the opportunity on that day.

BLESSED SEBASTIAN VALFRE, C.O.



When Sebastian Valfre joined the Oratory of Turin as a 22vear-old seminarian in 1651. the community was down to one member. By the time of his ordination the following

year, three more priests had joined the Oratory; this was a sign of the great impact Fr. Valfre would have on the Church in Piedmont and beyond.

Fr. Valfre is known for his work with the poor, despite his attempts to work discreetly and anonymously. He was particularly effective in his service of the poor during the famine of 1678-80 and the 17-week siege of Turin during the war between Piedmonte and Louis XIV. He is still invoked as patron of military chaplains for his ministry to soldiers during the war.

As a confessor, Fr. Valfre was known for his attentiveness and compassion. Along with his promotion of Marian devotion and the Forty Hours, his work in the confessional is credited with a religious revival in Turin, and he served as confessor to the royal family of Piedmont. He declined appointment as archbishop of Turin out of humility.

Fr. Valfre was also a scholar, earning a doctorate in theology at age 27. His writings run to 22 volumes, including a catechism called the Compendium of Christian Doctrine, which remained in use until the pontificate of Pope St. Pius X. The Apostle of Turin died on January 30, 1710. He was beatified by Pope Gregory XVI in 1834. (New Brunswick Oratory, NJ) There will be a Sung English Mass at Holy Family Church at 5:30 p.m.


