**A NOTE ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS**

If you have been thinking about requesting a Mass for a special intention, now is a good time – we have lots of openings! Call the parish office at 416-535-7646, or drop by before 1:30 p.m. (10:30 a.m. on Tuesdays).

What does it mean to have a Mass offered for a specific intention? An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Usually, a stipend is given to the priest for offering the Mass, which thereby in justice creates an obligation which must be satisfied. The tradition of offering Masses for others, particularly the dead, originates in the very early Church. When we face the death of someone, even a person who is not Catholic, to have a Mass offered for the repose of his soul and to offer our prayers are more beneficial and comforting than any

other sympathy card or bouquet of flowers. To have a Mass offered on the occasion of a birthday, anniversary or special need is appropriate, beneficial and appreciated. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

**PILGRIMAGE TO MARTYRS' SHRINE –  
AUGUST 6 - 11**

This is a walking pilgrimage for youth, open to boys and girls going to grade 9 and older. It will be supervised by Fr. Martin Hilbert and several adult helpers. Meet at Holy Family for Mass on Monday, August 6 at 8:30 a.m. Breakfast will be provided in the parish hall after Mass. We will then drive to Colgan, Ontario, where we will begin to walk, till we arrive at Midland on Friday, August 10. We stay overnight at Martyrs' Shrine and ride back to

Toronto the afternoon of August 11. the total walking distance is 110 km, mostly along cycling and snowmobile trails and roads free of traffic. Sleeping accommodations will be in parish halls and tents on parish grounds - modesty and privacy being preserved between facilities for boy and girls.

What to Bring: Sleeping bag/blanket & pad; clothing (especially socks!); personal toiletries; water bottle; rosary; backpack; good walking shoes; sun hat!

What NOT to Bring: Electronic gadgets (cell/smart phones, games, MP3 players, etc.). The only exception is cameras.

Pilgrims will need to carry their belongings, at least part of the way, so pack lightly. Soap, shampoo, toothpaste, sunscreen, mosquito spray will be provided.

Cost: \$60/pilgrim (if cheques, payable to Fr. Martin Hilbert)
