STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

The present phase of the stained glass window restoration has been completed by Han Stained Glass at a cost of 55,000 including GST. The company made a donation to the parish of \$5,250, for which we are most grateful. Nevertheless, we had to take out a loan of \$20,000 to pay the contract. By doing this project before July 1, we saved over \$4,000 in increased taxes, so it made sense to take out a loan. But it needs to be paid back. Please keep that in mind when making your contributions to the parish, especially to the Maintenance and Debt Fund.

Many people have noted how bright the restored windows are, especially when compared to the 8 windows on the north and south walls of the nave that have yet to be done. We hope to continue with this work as soon as we can afford it!

ST. ROMUALD'S BRIEF RULE FOR CAMALDOLESE MONKS

Saint Romuald was an Abbot and founder of the Camaldolese Benedictans. He was born around 950 in Ravenna, Italy and died on June 19, 1027. Horrified at his father's sin of murdering a relative in a duel, Romuald retired to a Benedictine monastery to do penance, and he remained there from 996 to 999. For almost thirty years he traveled about Italy, reforming monasteries and establishing hermitages. Romuald's own father eventually became a monk in one of his monasteries; when he later wavered in his vows, his son's encouragement helped him remain faithful. The last fourteen years of Romuald's life were spent in seclusion. The following is his brief rule:

Sit in your cell as in paradise. Put the whole world behind you and forget it. Watch your thoughts like a good fisherman watching for fish. The path you must follow is in the Psalms — never leave it.

If you have just come to the monastery, and in spite of your good will you cannot accomplish what you want, take every opportunity you can to sing the Psalms in your heart and to understand them with your mind.

And if your mind wanders as you read, do not give up; hurry back and apply your mind to the words once more.

Realize above all that you are in God's presence, and stand there with the attitude of one who stands before the emperor.

Empty yourself completely and sit waiting, content with the grace of God, like the chick who tastes nothing and eats nothing but what his mother brings him.
