A NOTE ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

What does it mean to have a Mass offered for a specific intention? An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Usually a stipend is given to the priest for offering the Mass, which thereby in justice creates an obligation which must be satisfied. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions. The first week is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The topic for the second week varies each year. The first session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session.

There are three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated. And lunch is served. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The Oratory can accommodate a limited number of people in the seminary residence. The fee for the course is \$150 per session which includes lunch. The surcharge for rooms in the seminary residence is \$50 per week. Please note that the courses are aimed at adults and older teens.
