Usually a stipend is given to the priest for offering the Mass, which thereby in justice creates an obligation which must be satisfied. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

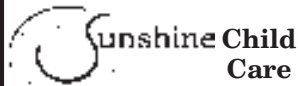
