FINANCIAL REPORT

If you missed the Financial Report for the parish for the year 2014, please pick up a copy. I spoke last weekend at all Masses about this, and presented the budget needs for 2015 as determined by the Finance Committee of the Parish. In addition to our monthly receipts from PAG and other sources of income, we need an average of \$3,863 each week in the combined offertory, M & D, and Anniversary Fund collections to cover the expenses of the parish. We are now including this budget amount in each week's bulletin together with the collection totals. I also suggested, as indicated in the letter from the Finance Committee, that we all need to think seriously and prayerfully about whether we should be giving more on a regular basis, perhaps even tithing, giving 10% of our income to the Church and charities. Some people give 5% to the Church and 5% to other charities, and those who do all attest that God is generous with those who are generous with Him.
