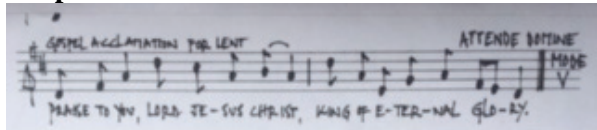

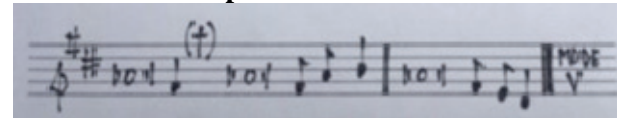

Regular Mass Schedule

Easter Monday: Mass at 10:00 a.m.

The regular weekday schedule of Masses and Confessions resumes on Tuesday. The whole week, from Easter Sunday until April 8(inclusive) is known as the Easter Octave. Each day is a solemnity, so Easter Friday is not a day of penance or abstinence from meat.
