The Finance Committee of the Parish has determined that in addition to our monthly receipts from PAG and other sources of income, we need an average of \$3,863 each week in the combined offertory, M & D, and Anniversary Fund collections to cover the expenses of the parish. We are now including this budget amount in each week's bulletin together with the collection totals. I have suggested, as indicated in the letter from the Finance Committee, that we all need to think seriously and prayerfully about whether we should be giving more on a regular basis, perhaps even tithing, giving 10% of our income to the Church and charities. Some people give 5% to the Church and 5% to other charities, and those who do all attest that God is generous with those who are generous with Him. Thank you to those who have already taken this message to heart.
