#### **ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY**

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions. The first week is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The topic for the second week varies each year. The first session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session. There are three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated. And lunch is served. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The Oratory can accommodate a limited number of people in the seminary residence. The fee for the course is \$150 per session which includes lunch. The surcharge for rooms in the seminary residence is \$50 per week. Please note that the courses are aimed at adults and older teens.
