#### **ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL**

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions. The first week is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The topic for the second week varies each year. The first session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session.

There are three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated and lunch is served.

Session 2: **July10-14**, The Church and Non-Believers The fee for **the course is \$175 per session**, which includes lunch. Simple accommodation is available in the Oratory's Seminary Residence.
