NOVENA TO ST. PHILIP NERI, AND FEAST DAY

Join the community of the Oratory in praying a novena to St. Philip Neri in preparation for his feast day, May 26. The novena **begins on Tuesday, May 17** and concludes on May 25. It will be prayed at Holy Family Church during the 5:30 weekday Masses, on Saturday at the

10:00 a.m. Mass, and on Sunday at 5:00 p.m. at Vespers.

First Vespers of St. Philip Neri will take place on Wednesday, May 25 at 7:30 p.m. There will be a sung Latin Mass in St. Philip's honor on Thursday, May 26, at 6:00 p.m. at Holy Family.

ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions. The first session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session. ST. FELIX OF CANTALICE, F.D. MAY 18

St. Felix of Cantalice was born to peasant parents in Cantalice, Italy. As a boy he worked hard as a farm laborer and shepherd, and, in 1543, became a Capuchin lay brother. It

is said that he was well noted for his piety. In 1547 he was sent to Rome as questor, begging for bread and wine for the friars, and spent his remaining 38 years aiding the sick and the poor. In Rome, Felix preached in the street, rebuked corrupt politicians and officials, and exhorted young men to stop leading dissolute lives. He also composed simple teaching canticles, and arranged for children to gather in groups to sing them as a way to teach them catechism. He could not even read, yet theologians consulted him on spirituality and Scripture. Felix was revered by all and was a companion of St. Philip Neri, who considered Felix the greatest saint then living. Once during Carnival, a time of open vice in the streets, St. Felix and St. Philip organized a procession of Capuchin friars right into the middle of the revelers. He was the first Capuchin to be canonized, on May 22, 1712. He is the saint from whom the Felician Sisters take their name. Saint Felix is shown bearing the Infant Jesus in his arms because of a vision he once had, when the Blessed Virgin appeared to him and placed the Divine Child in his arms.
