### ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions. The first week is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The lectures are very well suited to anyone involved in teaching catechism classes or RCIA, school teachers, or anyone who wants to come to a deeper knowledge and appreciation of his faith. The topic for the second week varies each year. The first session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session.

There are three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers of the Oratory. Mass is celebrated each day. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The fee for **the course is \$175 per session**, which includes lunch. For those who would like to avoid traveling each day, simple accommodation is available in the Oratory's Seminary Residence. The rooms are single, with shared bathrooms, and have access to simple cooking facilities and the Seminary Chapel. The cost for a room is \$75 per person, per week, and participants are responsible for bringing their own bedding for a single bed. Please note that the courses are aimed at adults and older teens.

### PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. PHILIP NERI

In celebration of the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of our Holy Father St. Philip Neri (21<sup>st</sup> July 1515), Pope Francis has granted a Jubilee Year with an attached Plenary Indulgence, subject to the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff). During the Jubilee Year, which runs from 25<sup>th</sup> May 2015 to 26<sup>th</sup> May 2016, the indulgence can be granted every day in our church (and in any other church of a canonically established Congregation of the Oratory). To gain the indulgence, a pilgrimage must be made, or one should take part in a service or devotion in honour of St. Philip, concluding by saying the Our Father and Creed and prayers to the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Philip. The indulgence may be applied to the faithful departed.

*The jubilee year ends on the Solemnity of St Philip, this Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>.*

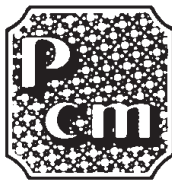
