It was, I guess, a blessing in disguise that we forgot the Anniversary Fund collection on April 19 are were able to take it up on the 26th when we had extra people in the church for the First Communion Mass! Still, it was only the third Sunday this year that we reached our budget need. Bank balance as of May 1: \$1,129.62. This includes \$2,306.05 collected for ShareLife and \$1,824.75 collected for the Holy Land, funds which are due to be remitted to the Archdiocese, leaving us a negative balance. We also owe \$3,920 to the St Vincent de Paul Society for moneys collected over the years in the poor boxes, and our cathedraticum bill to the Archdiocese has also come in and is due: \$5,405. (The Archdiocese kindly charges us a low tax rate.)

These funds are passed on to the Holy Father for immediate response in countries stricken by war, famine and natural disasters. 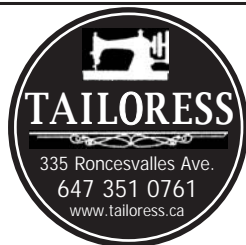
