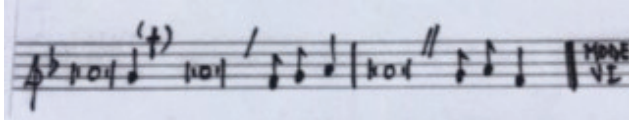

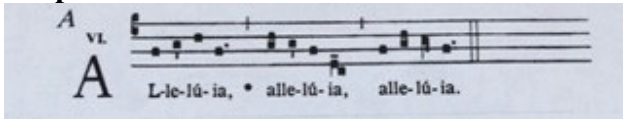

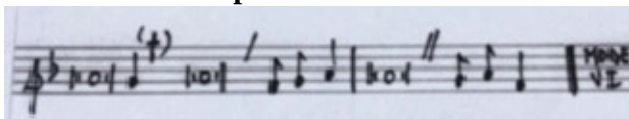

Spirit, to spread the Gospel throughout the world. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to kindle in us the fire of divine love. Traditionally, and still in some countries, the feast of the Ascension is celebrated forty days after Easter, on a Thursday, which this year falls on May 10. In Canada, for the Ordinary Form of the Mass, the Solemnity is transferred to the next Sunday. For those who celebrate the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, the liturgy of the Ascension is still celebrated on the Thursday.
