

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

St Vincent's greatest collaborator and close friend, St Louise de Marillac, did not have an ideal childhood. She was born out of wedlock and never knew her mother. She entered this world on August 12, 1591 in Paris. Her powerful and wealthy father allowed the Dominican sisters to raise her. Her father died when she was 12 years old. Do we need perfect upbringings to become holy? No. "God chooses the weak," we pray at Mass, "and makes them strong through Jesus Christ."

Wisdom from St Vincent de Paul:

"And so, Sisters, I beseech God to give you this virtue of prudence for he knows you need it because, Sisters, you have to deal with all sorts of people, with people of rank and condition and with the poor. It is necessary to know how to behave in all circumstances. And how can this be done? By prudence. . . Prudence, then, Sisters, is a virtue which causes us to strive to do everything in the way it should be done" (3 July 1660, "On the Virtues of Louise de Marillac).
