#### PLENARY INDULGENCE IN NOVEMBER



Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in

peace.

A plenary indulgence, to be applied to the souls of the faithful departed, can be gained by a visit to a cemetery from **November 1 to 8** (inclusive) to pray for the dead, under the usual conditions, which are:

- Going to confession within 7 days (before or after) of performing the indulgenced act.
- Receiving Communion within 7 days of performing the indulgenced act.
- Prayer for the Pope's intentions.
- Detachment from sin, even venial sin, while performing the act. To the extent that one's detachment is not perfect, the plenary indulgence becomes a partial indulgence.

### BL. SALVIO HUIX MIRALPEIX, PRAY FOR US



Blessed Salvio was born on December 22, 1877 in Santa Margarida de Vellors in the Diocese of Vic in Catalonia, Spain. He was ordained a priest in 1903 and four years later he entered the Congregation of the Oratory of Vic. For twenty years he lived

the Oratorian life of prayer, teaching and administering the Sacraments. In 1927, he became the Provost of the Vic Oratory, and then nominated as Bishop of Ibiza. He was imprisoned when the Republican forces broke out, 1936. With his fellow prisoners he shared suffering and the joys of secret prayers and Masses. He died a martyr's death when he was shot by Republican forces on the morning of August 5, 1936. The beatification of Bishop Miralpeix, the first Oratorian martyr, took place in Tarragona, Spain, on October 13, 2013. There will a Sung English Mass at Holy Family Church on November 6, at 5:30 p.m.


