BLESSED SALVIO HUIX MIRALPEIX, PRAY FOR US

Blessed Salvio was born on December 22, 1877 in Santa Margarita de Vellors in the Diocese of Vic in Catalonia, Spain. He was ordained priest on September 19, 1903 and entered the Congregation of the Oratory of Vic four years later. He was the Provost of the Vic Oratory when, in 1927, he was consecrated as bishop. He died a martyr's death when he was shot by Republican forces on the morning of August 5, 1936. We will honour this latest Oratorian Blessed this Wednesday, November 6 with a sung English Mass at Holy Family Church at 5:30 p.m.


