ADVENT FAMILY DAY OF RECOLLECTION

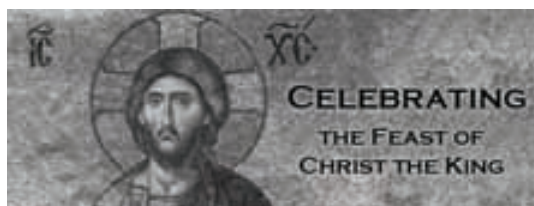
