



ST. ALOYSIUS SCROSOPPI, PRAY FOR US!!

Aloysius (Luigi) Scrosoppi (1804-1884) did not spend most of his long life as an Oratorian, but that was because political upheavals on more than one occasion suppressed the Oratory in Udine, his native city in the north-east of Italy. He is the founder of the Sisters of Providence, whose work it was to help orphans. These sisters are now active in many parts of the world. But the miracle which paved the way for his canonization was in favour of an Oratorian novice in South Africa who was dying of AIDS. His feast day is October 5.

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER



Do you know your church?

On the ceiling, just above the entrance to the sanctuary, we see a *fifth and final* medallion depicting the two stone tablets with the 10 Commandments on them. God gave Moses two stone tablets with two sets of commandments. I-III tell us how to love God. IV-X tell us how to love our fellow human beings. But why place an image of the Ten Commandments at the altar rail where we receive Holy Communion?

What do these two tablets have to do with the Eucharist?

1) Christ in the Eucharist enables us by His own strength to keep the Ten Commandments. 2) The two tablets remind us that Christ has two natures (true God and true man) and that by loving Him in the Eucharist we fulfill the two great commandments. 3) At the Last Supper Christ gave two commandments regarding his Eucharistic Body: take this, all of you, and eat of it. 4) All of the above. 5) None of the above.

Last week's Answer: All of the above. The Holy Spirit inspires us to come to Mass. The Holy Spirit recalls Christ to our minds in the Mass. The Holy Spirit makes Christ present in the Eucharist as he overshadowed Mary at the Annunciation. Christ fills us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit in Holy Communion so that we might bear much fruit!

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

After St Vincent de Paul died on September 27, 1660, many people reported special healings after visiting his tomb or invoking his aid. 37 years after St Vincent de Paul died, an official Church investigation into his holiness began. By 1713, having reviewed his life and all his writings, the Church declared that he had lived a life of heroic Christian love. Among the many alleged miracles, two cures were especially studied by medical experts who later attributed them to the work of Vincent de Paul. There was a nun cured of ulcers, and a laywoman who was healed of paralysis. Subsequently, Pope Benedict XIII beatified Vincent on August 13, 1729. Less than a decade later, Pope Clement XIII officially canonized him on June 16, 1737. He is the patron saint of charities, hospitals, volunteers, prisoners, and horses. Thank you to all who volunteered for the celebration of his annual feast!
