THE PARISH FINANCES: A SPECIAL APPEAL FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND DEBT COLLECTION, NOVEMBER 4

A number of large bills have recently come due all at once:
\$6,384.15 (quarterly payment to the Receiver General),
\$5,951 (our mandatory contribution to the Archdiocese),
and the insurance bill for \$3,485.68 (one instalment of four,
the next of which is due is December). In the past year we
have spent approximately \$30,000 on maintenance and
improvements to the physical fabric of the church (\$20,000
on a new roof for the rectory and \$10,000 on repairs and
renovations to the office space and to the apartment on the
ground floor of the rectory, which we are now able to rent at
a higher rate than previously.) These expenses were covered
out of existing funds, that is, we did not take a loan from the
archdiocese to pay for them. For this reason parish finances
are severely stretched. The next collection will take place
next Sunday, on November 4 (rather than November 25 as
originally scheduled). Please make use of envelopes in this
week's bulletin, and please be generous.

PLENARY INDULGENCE IN NOVEMBER



Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

A plenary indulgence, to be applied to the souls of the faithful departed, can be gained by a visit to a cemetery from **November 1 to 8** (inclusive) to pray for the dead, under the usual conditions, which are:

- Going to confession within 7 days (before or after) of performing the indulgenced act.
- Receiving Communion within 7 days of performing the indulgenced act.
- Prayer for the Pope's intentions.
- Detachment from sin, even venial sin, while performing the act. To the extent that one's detachment is not perfect, the plenary indulgence becomes a partial indulgence.

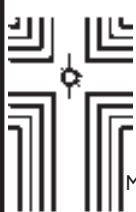
