Aloysius (Luigi) Scrosoppi (1804-1884) did not spend most of his long life as an Oratorian, but that was because political upheavals on more than one occasion suppressed the Oratory in Udine, his native city in the north-east of Italy. He is the founder of the Sisters of Providence, whose work it was to help orphans. These sisters are now active in many parts of the world. But the miracle which paved the way for his canonization was in favour of an Oratorian novice in South Africa who was dying of AIDS. His feast day is October 5. For the Fathers of the Oratory and our parishes, his feast is transferred this year to October 6. There will be a sung Mass at 5:30 p.m. at Holy Family Church.



John Henry Newman (1801-1890) was an Anglican clergyman and a teacher at Oxford University. In 1845, at the age of 44, he became a Roman Catholic and soon after was ordained a priest. He established the English Oratory of St. Philip Neri. He was ordained a cardinal by Pope Leo XIII, in 1879. In Birmingham, England on September 19, 2010 he was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI, giving him the title Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman. His feast day is October 9. There will be a sung Mass at 5:30 p.m. at Holy Family.




