Down the centre of the ceiling in the nave, we have five medallions connected to the Eucharist. The first medallion over the organ is of the pious pelican feeding its young with its own body. What does the second medallion represent? It shows a lamb standing on a book with a flag of victory. The medallion represents: 1) Jesus the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. 2) Jesus the Lamb of God who was slain, but rose, and lives forever to make intercession for us. 3) Jesus the Lamb of God who is offered up in every Mass by the words contained in the Missal on which he stands. 4) All of the above.

*Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:* In his late 30s, St Vincent de Paul set about to do something about the great poverty in Paris itself. What was one man amidst so many problems? From the beginning, he had helpers. His original helpers were the wealthy women of Paris whom he formed into a Confraternity of Charity. They not only collected money, but also helped directly in the work with the poor. They charity begin to reach outside of Paris. From this group of volunteers, a new religious order was founded and a new group of lay women was founded.
