



100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER



Do you know your church?

As we approach the sanctuary, we can see a fourth medallion on the ceiling depicting a seven branch candle stand. The candle stand represents the Holy Spirit and his seven gifts (wisdom, understanding, courage, counsel, piety, knowledge, and fear of the Lord). All the images in the centre of the ceiling lead us to the Holy Eucharist.

What does the Holy Spirit have to do with the Holy Eucharist? 1) The seven candles represent the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit which Christ's soul shares with us and increases in us at Mass. 2) The Holy Spirit draws us into the Mass and helps us believe in Christ, for "no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit." 3) The Holy Spirit is the one who, through the words of Christ, transforms the bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ . 4) All of the above. 5) None of the above.
