#### THE FEAST OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL – SEPTEMBER 27

Today is the feast of our beloved patron! Please note that the Oratory calendar is in error concerning the Mass in his honour on Monday the 28th. There will be no Mass on Monday, September 28 at 8:00 p.m. - rather the Mass celebrating St. Vincent will take place on Sunday the 27<sup>th</sup>. Also, the faithful have the opportunity for a plenary indulgence if they attend Mass at St. Vincent de Paul Church on his feast. The normal requirements set by the Church for plenary indulgences are that within several days before or after the visit to a church on the day of the patron's feast, the person participates in the Sacrament of Penance and receives the Holy Eucharist. On the day of the visit, the person is to pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, "by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary; nevertheless, the individual faithful are free to recite any other prayer according to their own piety and devotion toward the Supreme Pontiff". The indulgence becomes partial to the extent that one is not fully detached from sin.




