LIFE CHAIN – TODAY!

His Holiness, late Pope John Paul II in His Encyclical Letter “*The Gospel of Life*” said: “...procured abortion is the deliberate and direct killing, by whatever means it is carried out, of a human being in the initial phase of his or her existence, extending from conception to birth” Many forget that the status quo in Canada is any abortion, at any time, for any reason, at taxpayer expense. Many don't realize that as a Catholic Christian we need to defend life and publicly oppose abortion. Life Chain is a simple and prayerful way to give public witness to the Truth that abortion is a violent destruction of human life. It takes only an hour and all you have to do is stand quietly with others, holding a sign with a simple message, such as “Abortion kills Children”, “Abortion hurts Women”, and “Adoption the Loving Option”.
