A NOTE ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

What does it mean to have a Mass offered for a specific intention? An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Usually, a stipend is given to the priest for offering the Mass, which thereby in justice creates an obligation which must be satisfied. The tradition of offering Masses for others, particularly the dead, originates in the very early Church. When we face the death of someone, even a person who is not Catholic, to have a Mass offered for the repose of his soul and to offer our prayers are more beneficial

and comforting than any other sympathy card or bouquet of flowers. To have a Mass offered on the occasion of a birthday, anniversary or special need is appropriate, beneficial and appreciated. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

If you have been thinking about requesting a Mass for a special intention, now is a good time – we have lots of openings! Call the parish office at 416-535-7646, or drop by before 1:00 p.m. (except on Wednesdays).

Evenings at the Oratory – What are they?

The Oratory grew out of St. Philip's efforts to spread the Gospel, through talks and music, to the people of Rome in the sixteenth century. Each afternoon, four talks were given, on prayer, the life of virtue, and on Church history. In between the talks, music lifted the souls of the listeners to God. These afternoon sessions, called the Secular Oratory, were well-attended by people of all backgrounds: from the most prominent cardinals, prelates, and nobility to the lowest servant. In 1575, when the Oratory first received papal recognition there were forty priests dedicate to this apostolate. Circumstances change. The pace of life today does not permit people to spend every afternoon or evening listening to talks. Nor can a smaller community of priests with other apostolates produce four serious talks every day. Nevertheless, we hope that the Evenings at the Oratory are a legitimate adaptation of Saint Philip's work for our times. Presentation in the Parish Hall followed by refreshments concluded with Sung Compline in the Church.
