

As reported October 18, 2020, the Archdiocese requested the Renovation be split into 2 phases due to cost increases and budget constraints.

Phase 1 of the Hall renovation is nearing completion! This weekend we will have access to the men's and women's washrooms, however, the universal washroom will not be open this week-end.

We anticipate gaining access to the Hall by the end of June at which point we will also have access to the kitchen with hot and cold water. There will be a stove top and wall oven. The dishwasher, fridge, freezer and prep table will be installed later. The light fixtures and air conditioning will be installed and functioning. The stage will not be built but the flooring will be finished. The moveable partition, sound system, and new windows will be installed in the future. A new security system for the church and rectory is being installed.
